

# SFX CC Poker Tournament Rules

Approved with changes in red  
September 9, 2024

Rules will be as follows:

COST:

\$40 (\$30 to the prize pool, ~~\$10 will be donated to the SFX CC~~). It will end with one final table at the end with 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prizes. No re-buyins. Players will have to pre register on sfxcc.com in the Events/Men's night/poker tournament. Choose either \$10 registration to attend without playing poker, \$40 to sign up for a spot at a poker table. *Payment will be taken at door.*

Max 8 players/table with a max of 4 tables. All players will have to pre-register at least 1 day before the tournament to decide player numbers per table.

## The Game:

- Starting stack 7500 in chips. Every player will get the following chips to start; 5-1000's (green), 3-500's (blue) 8-100's (red) and 4-50's (white)
- Blinds levels are 20 minutes.
- The tournament will have a maximum time of 4 hrs from the start time (not including intermissions)
- 15-20 min intermission after 1hr 15min of runtime, another after 3 hrs
- Deciding dealer button, every player cuts the deck, highest card is dealer, if tied between players, the tied players redraw til it's decided
- Minimum bet will be same as big blind/Level.
- Minimum raise is 2x big blind, no max

- Once a player is out of chips, they are eliminated from the table, no re-buyins
- As the tournament goes on and players get eliminated we will move players to another table to keep the tables even, moving them clockwise starting at table 1 to have one final table at the end
- Only the English language will be used at the tables
- In split pots with an uneven amount of chips, extra chip(s) goes to player closest clockwise from the dealer button
- Chips must be in sight for other players to see
- Misdeal if one of the first 2 cards flip over that are dealt to each player
- As tournament progresses at each table, anytime after Level 6, can reevaluate chip values and exchange lower valued chips to higher valued to keep stack sizes smaller
- Players can get up to use bathrooms and

game will pause (within reason, not all the time!)

- No cheating!

The following denominations explain  
Small/Big/Ante

Level 1 - 50 / 50 / 0

Level 2 - 50 / 100 / 0

Level 3 - 100 / 200 / 200

Level 4 - 150 / 300 / 300

Level 5 - 200 / 400 / 400

Level 6 - 200 / 500 / 500

Level 7 - 300 / 600 / 600

Level 8 - 400 / 800 / 800

Level 9 - 500 / 1000 / 1000

Level 10 - 600 / 1200 / 1200

Level 11 – 800 / 1600 / 1600

Level 12 – 1000 / 2000 / 2000

Level 13 – 1500 / 3000 / 3000

Level 14 – 2000 / 4000 / 4000

Level 15 – 3000 / 6000 / 6000

Prizes:

Prize will be a total maximum of \$960  
(\$30x32 players max)

3rd prize - 20% of pot

2nd prize - 30%

1st prize - 50%

- if there's a tie for 3rd/4th, it'll be a split  
percentage of 20%

- if there's a tie for 2nd/3rd, it'll be a split  
~~spot~~ of the combined 50%

if there's a tie for 1st/2nd, it'll be a split pot of the combined 80%

Prizes will be awarded to top 3 players with the highest chip value being awarded 1st place prize, second highest value 2nd prize, and so on if all players not eliminated.
